Sari Rautio serves as the Director for Security Policy and Crisis Management within the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland since April 2018. Previously she held the position of Director for EU's Common Foreign and Security Policy (2015-2018) in Helsinki and the Deputy Representative of Finland to the EU Political and Security Committee (PSC) in Brussels (2012-2015). Her earlier assignments within the Ministry entailed security policy, crisis management, UN policies, and the Middle East. She has served in Finnish Embassies in Moscow (2005-2008) and Addis Abeba (2002-2005).

With a Master's degree in Social Sciences (political science), Sari's diplomatic career has focused on security policy, on EU's foreign, security and defence policy, on Russia and on the security and development nexus, including in Africa. In her current capacity she manages issues regarding Russia and security at the Baltic Sea, EU's security and defence policy, Finland's partnership with Nato, cyber and hybrid threats and Finland's participation in international crisis management.
